- 18 Minutes of the Meeting of the Annual Council and Ordinary meeting held on 24 May 2021**
18.01 Minutes of the Meeting of the Annual Council and Ordinary meeting held on 24 May 2021 were confirmed as a true record.

Matters arising

18.01/9.02/62.02 Quote for the railings had been requested
18.02/9.03/62.03/58.05 The no dog fouling signs would be erected soon by Councillor Potter and Rees. Due to the number of dogs on the main beach that were prohibited as from the 1st of May, it was agreed that two pavement signs would be purchased with a rigid panel holder.

Adroddwyd y byddai Cliff Bates yn codi'r faner las yr wythnos hon ac y byddai'r Cynghorydd B Stones yn gallu cynorthwyo. Hefyd, roedd yr achubwyr bywyd wedi bod ar y traeth o'r 19 Mehefin.

18.05 / 10.01 Roedd fideo wedi'i recordio o HGV yn gyrru dros yr holl bolardiau y tu allan i'r *Seahorse*. Roedd nifer hefyd wedi bod dod yn rhydd. Trafodwyd a oedd hi'n bosibl mai dim ond HGV 30 troedfedd y caniateir yn lle 40 troedfedd. Fodd bynnag, nodwyd mai gyrrwyr y loriâu 30 troedfedd a oedd wedi niweidio'r bolardiau mewn llawer o achosion.

18.06 / 10.04 Plannwyd y blodau gan y grŵp W4NQ ac fe'u prynwyd trwy Shell on Earth. Diolchodd yr aelodau i'r grŵp am eu gwaith.

18.07 / 15.07 Oherwydd coïvd, rhagwelwyd y byddai'r neuadd ar agor ym mis Medi. Roedd Clonc wedi ailgychwyn. Hefyd roedd cesiadau eraill yn cael eu hystyried gan mai dim ond 50 o bobl oedd yn cael caniatâd yn y brif neuadd ar hyn o bryd.

18.08 / 9.08 / 67.06 Roedd y sgaffaldiau wedi'i dynnu.

18.03/9.05 Councillor Potter apologised that he had the incorrect location when Environmental Health had contacted him. The sign would now be located at the correct location.

18.04/9.07/67.05 The public conveniences by the watersports centre remained closed. A sign was requested on the end of Penpolion to inform the public that they were closed. Councillor Potter to contact Cliff Bates to discuss. Also a further email would be sent by Councillor Potter to request that the public conveniences were required to be open due to the need to social distance as the other conveniences were very busy and therefore a public health issue. It was reported that Cliff Bates would be erecting the blue flag this week and Councillor B Stones would be able to assist. Also, the lifeguards had been on the beach as from the 19 June.

18.05/10.01 a video had been recorded of a HGV driving over all the bollards outside the Seahorse. A number had also been loose. Discussion emanated if it was possible that 30ft lorries were only allowed to drive through the bottom of the town instead of 40ft. However, it was noted that in many cases it was the drivers of the 30ft lorries that had damaged the bollards.

18.06/10.04 The flowers had been planted by the W4NQ group and had been purchased via Shell on Earth. Members thanked the group for their work.
